

Safety and Quality Credentials

When planning an event, safety has to be a primary concern. Whilst our marquees are truly beautiful, they are also extremely well manufactured in New Zealand. This is so important for peace of mind as well as for complying to the required building consents needed to erect a marquee (temporary structure.)

We have sourced all of our other elements to comply with the strict regulations too, this way you can be safe, and we can provide you with a service that is fully insured and professionally handled.

Before your event takes place we will contact the council and arrange the relevant permits for you on your behalf as part of our costs, we will supply you with a copy of the permit well before your event date, and we recommend that someone has a copy onsite at all times (we can help with this by bringing a spare copy on set up day and leaving it with someone.) This way you know that you are covered!

All of our relevant documentation is available by request including our 'made in New Zealand' marquees, something we're really proud of.

Please note: We include Building Consent costs in all of our packages as standard. This is a legal requirement for all temporary structures (marquees) over 100 mtr² in New Zealand.

Key Features

- All our marquees are very quiet and stable in windy conditions - no problem with winds of 80kph (officially rated and guaranteed), this is the maximum obtainable rating for any marquee.
- High performance marquee material, 100% waterproof, (officially rated and guaranteed), built for optimum strength, durability, look and quality.
- Certificated fire proof marquee material, exceeding all the stringent standards for NZ, AUS, UK, and USA including all the marquee linings. (officially rated and guaranteed)
- All our specific marquee carpeting is tested in accordance with flammability BS4790: 1987 so will meet the highest standards and falls well within all the NZ local council limits.
- All of our lighting options carry the NZ standards as well as the British Kite Mark.
